English Major: 30 credits, including Writing about Literature, 1 class in American literature, 1 class in British literature, 1 class in literature written pre-1800s, 1 class in Diverse literature, 2 electives (in either ENGL or ENCW), and Senior Inquiry. Only one 1xx level class will count towards the major, and at least 4 classes must be at the 3xx level. Note: courses may satisfy only one major requirement (e.g., ENGL 315 can count for British or pre-1800s, but not both).
