Key Points: Academic Credit

The number of academic credits assigned to a course is based on the amount of work required in the course.*

One credit = Approximately one hour of class per week during a 14-week semester

Most Augustana courses carry 4 credits

Typical first year at Augustana College

| Fall semester | 13-14 credits | Three 4-credit courses + one or two 1-credit courses |
|-----------------|---------------|--|
| J-term | 4 credits | One 4-credit course |
| Spring semester | 16 credits | Four 4-credit courses |
| Total | 34 credits | |

Lighter load in first semester = more time to transition to college!

- Meet higher academic expectations
- Make new friends
- Get involved on campus
- Get used to living independently

Your Augustana degree requires a minimum of 124 credits

• 31 credits per year x 4 years = 124 credits

Credit = Time in class

Outside of class, expect at least 2 hours of studying for each hour spent in class

• 14 credits = 14 hours in class + at least 28 hours studying = full-time job!
